

JACKSON COUNTY AGREEMENT TO ESTABLISH THE CONSTITUENT
UNITS OF GOVERNMENT WITHIN THE
SOUTHERN ILLINOIS CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRAINING REGION
AS A "MOBILE TEAM IN-SERVICE TRAINING UNIT"

WHEREAS, the counties of Alexander, Clay, Crawford, Edwards, Effingham, Fayette, Franklin, Gallatin, Hamilton, Hardin, Jackson, Jasper, Jefferson, Johnson, Lawrence, Marion, Massac, Perry, Pope, Pulaski, Richland, Saline, Union, Wabash, Wayne, White, and Williamson together with the many municipalities contained therein, have for many years cooperated in local efforts to improve the law enforcement and criminal justice systems in said counties and municipalities through the Southern Illinois Criminal Justice Training Program operated by the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission.

WHEREAS, through that association the aforesaid counties and municipalities have determined that there is a need to plan, coordinate and deliver training for the numerous public law enforcement agencies involved in said systems; and

WHEREAS, by means of the Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officers In-Service Training Act (P.A. 82-674), the General Assembly and Governor of Illinois have determined that local efforts to achieve such planning and coordination for local law enforcement training should be expanded and strengthened through a program commonly known as the "Mobile Team In-Service Training Unit"; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Local Governmental Law Enforcement Officers Training Board has approved certain resolutions, regulations and guidelines to implement the aforesaid training program in Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the County of Jackson has determined that the aforesaid training program is one which would benefit said county, as well as the various other counties and municipalities within the Southern Illinois Criminal Justice Training Region,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, pursuant to Article 7, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 and the provisions of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, and otherwise:

(1) The County of Jackson hereby authorizes the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission to establish and maintain a "Local Training Advisory Board" as defined in the Intergovernmental Law Enforcement Officers In-Service Training Act, and agrees to cooperate through the Board so that it may fulfill the duties imposed upon such boards by state law and regulations.

(2) The County of Jackson hereby agrees, with the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission and each other participating unit of government within said Training Region, to cooperatively promote improvements in the law enforcement training services within said Region, and particularly those which transcend the departments, agencies or geographical boundaries of any single such unit, all as more fully set out in the bylaws of the Commission and operating procedures governing the Training Region.

(3) The County of Jackson hereby authorizes the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission to provide to the constituent governments those training services and activities permitted by the Act which are beneficial and in the best interests of the local governments participating in the training program.

(4) The County of Jackson hereby authorizes the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission to apply for, receive, utilize and expend state or other such funds as might be available to it to assist it in performing the foregoing services and activities, all in accordance with applicable law.

(5) It is understood that financial participation to support the programs and services of the Criminal Justice Region as conducted by the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission and the local training advisory board is met through Jackson County's continued membership and financial contribution to the Greater Egypt Regional Planning and Development Commission, except for such costs which may be necessary to conduct certain special programs or services that may be requested.

FORENSIC SCIENCE LABORATORY IN SOUTHERN ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the southern Illinois area is presently served by less than a full-service forensic laboratory; and

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois, Department of Law Enforcement is presently considering expansion of its Southern Illinois Forensic Services Laboratories to a full-service facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Carbondale and Southern Illinois University-Carbondale have proposed a location, facility and cooperative programs to the Department of Law Enforcement; and

WHEREAS, Southern Illinois University-Carbondale is uniquely suited to provide cooperative programs to the Training and Applications Laboratory of the Department of Law Enforcement, particularly through its School of Law, advanced degree programs in the sciences, Center for the Study of Crime, Delinquency and Correction, and School of Medicine; and

WHEREAS, the development of a full-service laboratory will enhance the state's laboratory system in general, and the Southern Illinois Law Enforcement agencies access to forensic services specifically, and

WHEREAS, said laboratory, by being located in Carbondale will best serve the southern Illinois area because of the SIU-C cooperative programs and access to the southern Illinois area; and

WHEREAS, said investment of State of Illinois resources should be in the economically distressed area of southern Illinois.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE

1. It supports the development by the State of Illinois of full forensic services in southern Illinois;
2. It supports the City of Carbondale and Southern Illinois University-Carbondale in its proposal to locate said laboratory services in Carbondale, such location maximizing state, local and university resources.
3. It supports further the location of the Illinois Department of Law Enforcement Training and Applications Laboratory in conjunction with the full-service laboratory in order to maximize the resources available through cooperation with Southern Illinois University-Carbondale.




