Good Samaritan Ministries requested funding at the same level as FY15 in the amount of \$4,199.00 for case management/coordination, life skills, vocational training and transitional services. The request was submitted on the short form.

Specialized Training for Adult Rehabilitation Inc. requested funding in the amount of \$56,847 for vocational and youth transition services. The request was submitted on the long form.

Centerstone requested funding in the amount of \$173,470.00 for Big Brother Big Sisters Prevention Specialist and Comprehensive Community Based Youth Services, Crisis Services, Outpatient Substance Abuse, Outpatient Mental Health Counselors. The request was submitted on the long form.

Archway, Inc. requested funding at the same level as FY15 in the amount of \$17,000 for the LIFT program providing developmental home based services and classroom based services to children from birth to five years of age who have a developmental delay. The request was submitted on the long form.

The Women's Center, Inc. requested funding at the same level as FY15 in the amount of \$19,900 serving thirty-seven families currently. The request was submitted on the long form.

Southern Illinois Center for Independent Living requested funding in the amount of \$7,260.00 for case coordination/management and community support services. The request was submitted on the short form.

Perry-Jackson Child Advocacy Center requested funding in the amount of \$10,000 for contractual services and capital improvements. It is the hopes of the center to establish a satellite office in Jackson County. The request was submitted on the long form.

Shawnee Health Service and Development Corporation requested funding in the amount of \$13,250 for counseling services with an emphasis on youth presenting at Terrier Care. The request was submitted on the long form.
