





WHEREAS, Jackson County wishes to apply for and use a credit card to conduct some of its regular business; and

WHEREAS, the convenience of a credit card allows for a more efficient method for the County to purchase goods, supplies, and other items from vendors; and

WHEREAS, in certain instances, using a credit card has become a more commonly used method of buying goods and services than purchase orders.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the County Board of Jackson County; Illinois as follows:

The following policy shall govern the use of a credit card:

1. **Eligibility** - The County Board hereby authorizes the County Treasurer's Office to apply for a credit card account. The credit card should not incur an annual fee or similar charge. The physical control the credit card will be under the County Treasurer's auspices. The credit card is the property of Jackson County and the privilege to use the credit card may be revoked at any time by the Jackson County Board. The County Treasurer's Office is authorized to perform any reasonable act required to obtain the credit card.
2. **Policy** – The County Administrator shall monitor and control the use of the credit card. The credit card is to be issued for the convenience of the County and for official county business related purposes only. The card(s) may be used by other county offices in accordance with this Resolution and the County Treasurer's card use policies. The County Treasurer shall submit a copy of the credit card statement, including the balance, to the County Board each month. Written procedures concerning the county issued credit card shall be adopted by the County Treasurer's Office.
3. **Procedures**
 - a. **Purchase Limits** – The credit card shall be subject to a maximum credit limit of \$20,000. An aggregate maximum use of the credit card is established at \$240,000 for each fiscal year. The County Treasurer shall document the use of the credit card and shall submit an invoice to the county office(s) that is/are responsible for the charges on the credit card. The balance of the credit card shall be paid in full each month. No purchases from the use of the credit card shall be made without prior authorization from the County Administrator or in their absence the County Treasurer.
 - b. **Usage** - Each office shall appoint a card administrator, pending County Administrator approval. A list of the suggested card administrators for each county office and the approved users shall be given to the County Administrator. The County Administrator shall then designate a card administrator for each office.
 - c. **Tax Exempt Status** – The users of the card should ensure that vendors are made aware of and provided with the county tax exemption information whenever applicable.

- d. Receipts – Receipts for all purchases made on the county issued business credit card are to be submitted to the County Treasurer. The County Treasurer shall reconcile all use of the card with the respective card administrator and county office that used it. The County Treasurer and the county office shall determine the proper line item to be charged for the expenditure caused by the use of the credit card. All documentation pertaining to the credit card and its use shall not be destroyed unless according to the written auditing orders and as permitted by the Local Records Act.
- e. Prohibited use – The county issued credit card may not be used for any personal items. Improper charges must be paid to the county immediately. Improper use of the card may result in disciplinary action. If anyone suspects the loss, theft, or possibility of unauthorized use of the credit card, the respective card administrator shall immediately notify the County Treasurer's Office.



1. **Eligibility**-The County Board hereby authorizes the Jackson County Ambulance Service to apply for a credit card account. The credit card account should not incur an annual fee or similar charge. The credit card account is the property of Jackson County and the privilege to use the account may be revoked at any time by the Director or the Jackson County Board. The use of the credit card account will be under the authorization of the Director or Major. The County Treasurer's Office is authorized to assist the Ambulance Department to perform any reasonable act required to obtain the credit card account.
2. **Policy**-The Ambulance Department shall monitor and control the use of the credit card account through the normal accounts payable procedures used by Jackson County. All expenditures shall be Ambulance Department related and all payments shall be made with Ambulance Department funds. All payments shall be made through the existing Jackson County accounts payable process requiring County Board approval and subject to County audit. The balance of the credit card shall be paid in full each month.
3. **Procedures**
 - a. **Purchase limits**-The credit card shall be subject to a maximum credit limit of \$7,500.00.
 - b. **Usage**-No purchases from the use of the credit card account shall be made without prior authorization from the Director or Major. The physical location of the credit card(s) shall remain locked and secured at the Ambulance Department. The card(s) will be checked out after receiving pre-authorization from the Director and replaced upon purchase completion. After receiving prior

- authorization from the Director or Major, any command staff or approved employee may potentially be an account user. A list of approved credit card account users has been attached as exhibit A. Unauthorized purchases will be grounds for discipline or dismissal.
- c. Receipts-All receipts shall be turned in as soon as practical after incurring the charge. All charges shall be accompanied with a description of purpose and shall be initialed by the Director or Major. Upon reconciliation, statements shall be uploaded into the Jackson County accounting system using the appropriate General Ledger budget code(s) to ensure each expense is accounted for in the budget approved by Jackson County.
 - d. Tax Exempt Status-The users of the account shall ensure that vendors are made aware of and provided with the county tax exemption information as applicable.
 - e. Prohibited use-The credit card account may not be used for any personal items. Improper purchases will be grounds for discipline or dismissal. If anyone suspects the loss, theft, or possibility of unauthorized use of the credit card account, it shall be immediately reported to the Director, Major or the County Treasurer.
 - f. Review-On a monthly basis accounts payable reports from the Ambulance Department shall detail each expenditure and the total expenditures made using the account. The Ambulance Department shall make available any additional information concerning credit card purchases available at the request of the Jackson County Board and/or the County Treasurer. No account payment shall be made without the review and approval of the Jackson County Board.

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR
THE JACKSON COUNTY SHERIFF**

WHEREAS, Section 5-1010 of the Counties Code [55 ILCS 5/5-1010] requires the County Board to establish the salary of County officers at a meeting prior to the election of the officers whose salary is being established; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(a) of the Local Government Officer Compensation Act [50 ILCS 145/2(a)] requires the salary of elected officers for local governments to be established at least one hundred eighty (180) days prior to the start of their term; and

WHEREAS, Section 2(b) of the Local Government Officer Compensation Act [50 ILCS 145/2(b)] requires the salary of elected officers of a county be set by ordinance or resolution of the County Board; and

WHEREAS, the Public Act 102-0699 was enacted on April 19, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Public Act 102-0699 amends the Counties Code by adding Section 3-6007.5 [55 ILCS 5/3-6007.5] as follows:

Section 3-6007.5. Sheriff's salary.

- (a) As used in this Section, "salary" is exclusive of any other compensation or benefits.
- (b) The salary of a sheriff elected or appointed after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly in a non-home rule county shall not be less than 80% of the salary set for the State's Attorney under Section 4-2001 for the county in which the sheriff is elected or appointed.
- (c) The State shall furnish 66 2/3% of the total annual salary to be paid to a sheriff. Said amounts furnished by the State shall be payable monthly by the Department of Revenue out of the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund or the General Revenue Fund to the county in which the sheriff is elected or appointed. The county shall furnish 33 1/3% of the total annual salary. ; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2001 of the Counties Code establishes the methods used to set the salary of the State's Attorney; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2001(a)(1) through (a)(4) of the Counties Code sets either a certain annual salary for the State's Attorney or an annual salary for State's Attorney "as set by the Compensation Review Board, whichever is greater" [55 ILCS 5/4-2001(a)(1) through (a)(4)]; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-2001(a)(5) of the Counties Code provides for the greater of the set salary or the salary "as set by the Compensation Review Board" to include "any cost of living adjustments as authorized by the Compensation Review Board" [55 ILCS 5/4-2001(a)(1)]; and

WHEREAS, the pursuant to Section 4-2001 of the Counties Code the Jackson County State's Attorney's annual salary along with any cost-of-living adjustments is set and authorized by the Compensation Review Board on an annual basis in July.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the annual salary for the Jackson County Sheriff shall be as follows:

1. Effective December 1, 2022, the Jackson County Sheriff's annual salary shall be set at no less than eighty percent (80%) of the Jackson County State's Attorney's salary as is set by the State of Illinois pursuant to Section 4-2001 of the Counties Code inclusive of any cost-of-living adjustments as authorized by the Compensation Review Board.
2. In addition to the salary provided for in Paragraph 1, the Sheriff shall an annual stipend to be paid by the Illinois Department of Revenue out of the Personal Property Tax Replacement Fund in the amount of six thousand five hundred dollars (\$6,500.00) as required by Section 4-6003(d) of the Counties Code [55 ILCS 5/4-6003(d)].
3. The definition of benefits for the Jackson Sheriff shall be defined by the County Board of Jackson County and shall be consistent with the other county-wide elected officials. The Jackson County Sheriff shall receive a Medicare eligible benefit of \$150 a month.

WHEREAS, 55 ILCS 5/4-6001 (c)(3) of the Counties Code provides that the County Clerk & Recorder, Circuit Clerk, and Treasurer receive a stipend from the State of Illinois in the amount of \$6500; and

WHEREAS, the annual compensation that is set by this present resolution shall begin for the term of office effective December 1, 2022; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Jackson County Board sets the Health Insurance Contribution Rate and the Dental/Vision Insurance Contribution Rate in accordance with the following schedule:

Starting December 1, 2022—Health Insurance \$89/month & Dental/Vision Insurance \$49/month
Starting December 1, 2023—Health Insurance \$94/month & Dental/Vision Insurance \$49/month
Starting December 1, 2024—Health Insurance \$99/month & Dental/Vision Insurance \$49/month
Starting December 1, 2025—Health Insurance \$104/month & Dental/Vision Insurance \$49/month

THEREFORE, the Jackson County Board sets the annual compensation based upon the CPI-PTELL Rate published by the Illinois Department of Revenue for the listed officers in accordance with the following schedule:

AN AMENDMENT TO RESOLUTION #2021-58,
ESTABLISHING; CIVIL FEES AND CRIMINAL AND TRAFFIC ASSESSMENTS
TO BE CHARGED BY THE CLERK OF THE CIRCUIT COURT

WHEREAS, the “Resolution Establishing Civil Fees and Criminal And Traffic Assessments to Be Charged by the Clerk of the Circuit Court” also known as 2021-58, approved by the County Board on the 20th day of July, 2021, currently sets forth the fees authorized by the County Board to be charged in both civil and criminal cases in Jackson County; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly passed comprehensive legislation in 2018, which completely overhauls the criminal, traffic and civil fee structures in the circuit courts throughout the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the legislation was to consolidate fees into unified schedules for all counties, to realign fees to be constitutional, and to provide for fee waivers for low income individuals; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2019, Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act, 705 ILCS 105/27.1b, sets out the fees to be charged in all counties in the State of Illinois by the Clerks of the Circuit Court for the filing of pleadings and for other services provided by the Clerks in civil cases; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act creates four schedules for civil filing fees, three schedules for civil appearance fees, and establishes various other fees that Clerks of the Circuit Court are authorized to assess in civil cases, all of which are generally classified as “not to exceed” amounts; and

WHEREAS, Section 27.1b provides that, unless otherwise specified, the amount of the fees shall be determined by ordinance or resolution of the county board and remitted to the county treasurer to be used for purposes related to the operation of the court system in the county; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2019, the newly-adopted Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act, 705 ILCS 105/135 *et seq.*, sets out minimum fines to be levied and assessments to be charged in criminal and traffic cases by the Clerks of the Circuit Court in all counties in the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Sections 15-5 through 15-65 of the Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act establish thirteen (13) assessment schedules for various criminal, traffic, conservation and non-traffic offenses, and for each schedule the County’s portion of the assessment is specifically listed; and

WHEREAS, there is other money collected by the clerk that shall be held and disbursed per statute; and

WHEREAS, Sections 15-5 through 15-65 break down how the assessment amounts are to be distributed to various County funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board for the County of Jackson, Illinois, that, the "Resolution Establishing Civil Fees and Criminal and Traffic Assessments to Be Charged by the Clerk of the Circuit Court," also known as 2021-58, is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. Civil Fees and Criminal Assessments

Civil fees and criminal assessments shall meet the requirements of Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act, 705 ILCS 105/27.1b, and the Criminal and Traffic Assessment Act, 705 ILCS 105/135 *et seq.*

Section 2. Civil Fees

- A.** Fees in civil matters shall be assessed and distributed as set forth herein, in compliance with Section 27.1b of the Clerks of Courts Act, 705 ILCS 105/27.1b.
- B.** The fees for filing a complaint, petition or other pleading initiating a civil action shall be as set forth in the schedules below in accordance with case categories established by the Illinois Supreme Court.
- C.** To defray the costs of maintaining a county law library and in compliance with 55 ILCS 5/5-39001, a fee of \$20 for the Law Library Fund shall be charged and collected by the clerk. The fee shall be paid at the time of filing the first pleading, paper, or other appearance filed by each party in all civil cases, but no additional fee shall be required if more than one party is represented in a single pleading, paper, or other appearance. The fees shall be in addition to all other fees and charges of the clerks, assessable as costs. The fee shall not apply to adoption cases, as set forth in 705 ILCS 105/27.1b(z)(2), which states that "No fee other than the filing fee contained in the applicable schedule shall be charged to any person in connection with an adoption proceeding."
- D.** Other fees may be added to civil fee schedules per Administrative Order or Rule of the Circuit Court with the approval of the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts, pursuant to the Clerks of the Courts Act 705 ILCS 105/27.1b(y).

1a. SCHEDULE 1 (705 ILCS 105/27.1b(a)(1) shall include the following case categories:

- ARBITRATION (AR) cases where the amount in controversy is \$15,000.01 or more;
- CHANCERY (CH) cases;
- DISSOLUTION WITH CHILDREN (DC) cases;
- DISSOLUTION NO CHILDREN (DN) cases;
- EMINENT DOMAIN (ED) cases;
- FAMILY (FA) cases, except:
 - Petitions filed pursuant to the Parental Notice of Abortion Act of 1995 (750 ILCS 70/1 *et seq.*)
 - Voluntary petitions to determine parentage filed pursuant to section 309 of the Illinois Parentage Act of 2015 (750 ILCS 46/309);
- FORECLOSURE (FC) cases;
- GOVERNMENTAL CORPORATION (GC) cases;
- LAW (LA) cases;
- LAW-MAGISTRATE (LM) cases where the amount in controversy is \$15,000.01 or more;
- MISCELLANEOUS CRIMINAL (MX) cases, except:

WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are defined and enumerated in the "State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's Act", 725 ILCS 210/1 et seq., as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly appropriates monies for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, one-third from the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's County Fund and two-thirds from the General Revenue Fund, provided that such funding receives approval and support from the respective Counties eligible to apply; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shall administer the operation of the appellate offices so as to insure that all participating State's Attorneys continue to have final authority in preparation, filing, and arguing of all appellate briefs and any trial assistance; and

20th NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Jackson County Board, in regular session, this December, 2022 does hereby support the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and designates the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor as its Agent to administer the operation of the appellate offices and process said appellate court cases for this County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are hereby authorized to act as Assistant State's Attorneys on behalf of the State's Attorney of this County in the appeal of all cases when requested to do so by the State's Attorney, and with the advice and consent of the State's Attorney, prepare, file, and argue appellate briefs for those cases; and also, as may be requested by the State's Attorney, to assist in the prosecution of cases under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act, and the Narcotics Profit Forfeiture Act. Such attorneys are further authorized to assist the State's Attorney in the trial and appeal of tax objections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor will offer Continuing Legal Education training programs to the State's Attorneys and Assistant State's Attorneys.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor may also assist the State's Attorney of this County in the discharge of the State's Attorney's duties in the prosecution and trial of other cases, and may act as Special Prosecutor if duly appointed to do so by a court having jurisdiction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor is duly appointed to act as a Special Prosecutor in this County by a court having jurisdiction, this County will provide reasonable and necessary clerical and administrative support and victim-witness coordination on an as-needed basis and will also cover all reasonable and necessary case expenses such as expert witness fees, transcripts, evidence presentation, documents, lodgings, and all other expenses directly related to the prosecution of the case.


