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AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT

OF AN ALTERED SPEED ZONE

01 - 1

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED by the Board of Jackson County, Illinois, that the basic statutory vehicular speed limits established by Section 11-604 of the Illinois Vehicle Code are more than that considered reasonable and proper on the highway listed below for which Grand Tower Township has maintenance responsibility and which is not under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation, State of Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that this Board has caused to be made an engineering and traffic investigation upon highway listed below; and,

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that, by virtue of Section 11-604 of the above Code, this Board determines and declares that reasonable and proper absolute maximum speed limit on Power Plant Road as listed below shall be 45 m.p.h.


A 45 mile per hour speed limit beginning at IL Rte. 3 and extending westerly to Bunge Grain Terminal for a total distance of 1.84 miles.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that signs be erected giving notice thereof in conformance with the standards and specifications contained in the Illinois Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after the erection of said signs giving notice of the maximum speed limits.

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REAPPORTIONMENT
OF JACKSON COUNTY, AND THE COMPOSITION AND
SALARY OF THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD

WHEREAS, the County of Jackson, Illinois is a county having a population of less than 3,000,000 inhabitants and the township form of government; and

WHEREAS, Division 2-3 of the Counties Code (55 ILCS 5/2-3001 et. seq.) provides that the county board shall by July 1, 1971 and each ten years thereafter reapportion its county so that each member of the county board represents the same number of inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the above cited Division requires that the county board determine the size of the county board, the districts from which members are elected, their salary, how a chairman is elected, the number of members elected, the number of members per district and how terms of office are determined.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Jackson County Board as follows:

1. All prior ordinances, resolutions, and motions adopted by the Jackson County Board pertaining to any matters or subjects herein are hereby repealed as of the effective date of this ordinance.
2. Definitions as used in this ordinance: the following words shall have the meanings indicated:
 - a. Board means the Jackson County Board.
 - b. District means a county board district as established by this ordinance.
 - c. Member or Board Member means a person elected to serve on the county board.
3. The size of the Board shall be fourteen (14) members.
4. The Board Members shall be elected from seven (7) Districts.
5. Two Board Members shall be elected from each of the seven (7) Districts.
6. The Chairman of the Board shall be a member of the Board and shall be elected by majority vote of the Board Members with a term of office which shall be two (2) years to commence on the first Monday of the month following the month in which members of the Board are elected.
7. The salary to be paid to Board Members shall be computed on a per meeting basis and the amount of that compensation shall be \$35.00 for each meeting.



8. The Board Members elected in 2002 shall determine by lot which Members shall serve for two (2) year terms and which for four (4) year terms. Their successors shall be elected to a four (4) year term. All terms shall commence on the first Monday of the month following the month of election.

9. In making the determination of lot as to which Members shall serve for two (2) and which for four (4) year terms, the Board shall provide the drawing the lots in such a manner as to insure that in each District one Member will draw a two (2) year term and one Member will draw a four (4) year term.

10. The seven (7) Districts from which Board Members are to be elected are described and numbered as follows:

District #1: Beginning at the NE corner of Section 1 T7S R5W, thence Easterly along Jackson – Perry and Jackson – Franklin County lines to the NE corner of Section 1 T7S R1W, thence South along the Jackson – Franklin and Jackson – Williamson county lines to the NE corner of Section 1, T8S R1W, thence Westerly along the North Township line of T8S R1W to the ICGRR. Thence South along the ICGRR to the South Township line of T8S R1W, Then West along the South Township line of T8S R1W to the SW corner of Section 31 T8S R1W. Thence Northerly to the centerline of Illinois Rt. 149, thence Southwesterly following said centerline to the centerline of Maes Rd., thence North following said centerline to the centerline of East Industrial Park Rd. thence West along said centerline to the centerline of Rts. 13/127, thence Northerly following the centerline of Rts. 13/127 to the centerline of Harrison Road, thence Westerly following said centerline to the SW corner of NW ¼ of Section 30 T8S R2W, thence North along the Levan/Somerset Township line to the NW corner of T8S R2W, said point also being the NE corner of Section 1 T8S R3W, thence West along the Levan/Ora Township line to the NW corner of Section 6 T8S R3W. Thence South along the Levan/Kinkaid Township line to the SW corner Section 31 T8S R3W which is also the SE corner of T8S R4W, thence Westerly along the Kinkaid/Fountain Bluff Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T9S R5W, thence South along the Degognia/ Fountain Bluff Township line to the SE corner of Section 24 T9S R5W thence North following the Jackson – Perry and Jackson – Randolph county lines to the point of beginning.

District #2: Beginning at the Jackson/Perry county line being on the West line of Section 19 T9S R4W, North along the Fountain Bluff/ Degognia Township line to the NW corner of Section 6 T9S R4W, thence Easterly along the Fountain Bluff/ Kinkaid Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T9S R4W, said line also being the SW corner of T8S R3W, thence commencing North along the Levan/Kinkaid Township line to the NW corner of Section 6 T8S R3W, thence Easterly along the Levan/Ora Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T8S R3W. thence South along the Levan/Somerset Township line to the SE corner of Section 36 T8S R3W which is also the NW corner of Section 6 T9S R2W continuing south along the Murphysboro/Sand Ridge Township lines to the centerline of

Rt. 149, thence South Easterly along said centerline to the centerline of S. 21st street, thence South along said centerline to the centerline of Commercial St. thence Easterly along such centerline to the centerline of S. 20th street, thence South to the Big Muddy River, thence East following the river to the centerline of Old Hwy 13, thence South Easterly along said centerline to the centerline of Rt 127, thence South along said centerline to the North line of Section 3 T10S R2W, thence East along the Murphysboro/Pomona Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T10S R2W, thence South along the Pomona/Makanda Township line to the NW corner of Section 18 T10S R1W, thence East along the North Section lines of Sections 18, 17 and 16 to the ICGRR, thence North following the ICGRR to the North Section line of Section 4 T10S R1W, thence East along the Makanda/Carbondale Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T10S R1W, thence South along the Jackson – Williamson County line to the SE corner of Section 36 T10S R1W, thence West along the Jackson - Union County line to the Jackson – Perry County line, thence North along the Jackson – Perry County line to the point of beginning.


District #3: Beginning at the centerline of Harrison Rd. at the West line of Section 30 T8S R2W going East along said centerline to the centerline of Rt. 127 thence South to the centerline of East Industrial Park Rd., thence East to the centerline of Maes Rd., thence South to the centerline of Rt. 149, thence North Easterly along said centerline to the East line of Section 25 T8S R2W, thence South along the Somerset/DeSoto Township line to the SE corner of Section 36 T8S R2W, thence West along the Somerset/Murphysboro Township line to the Murphysboro corporate limits even with the centerline of Watson Rd., then South along said corporate limits line to Rt. 13, thence following the Murphysboro corporate limit lines West along Rt. 13 thence South on Fiddler Ridge road, thence following the corporate limit lines to the centerline of Old Brick Rd., thence following said centerline to the Big Muddy River, thence South and West along the Big Muddy River to the centerline of South 20th street, thence North along said centerline to the centerline of Commercial street, thence West to the centerline of S. 21st street, thence North to the centerline of Rt. 149/Walnut street, thence West along said centerline to the West Section line of Section 6 T9S R2W, thence North along the Murphysboro/Sand Ridge Township line to the NW corner of Section 6 T9S R2W which is also the SW corner of Section 31 T8S R2W thence North following the Somerset/Levan Township line to the point of beginning.

District #4: Commencing at the NW corner of Section 6 T9S R1W, East along the Carbondale/DeSoto Township line to the ICGRR, thence South following the ICGRR to the East-West line junction, thence North Easterly along the East-West ICGRR to a line even with the centerline of N. Wall street, thence South along the centerline of N. Wall street to the South border of Attucks Park, thence East to Piles Creek, thence following Piles Creek South to the centerline of Main street, East along said centerline to the centerline of Lewis Ln., thence South along said centerline to the centerline of College street, thence West following said centerline to the centerline of Wall street, South to the centerline of East Freeman street, West to the centerline of Graham Ave., following said

centerline to the centerline of Main street, thence West along said centerline to the centerline of Striegel Rd, thence West to the centerline of Wood Rd., thence South along the centerline of Wood Rd., to the centerline of Old Hwy 13, thence West along said centerline to the Big Muddy River, thence North to the Murphysboro corporate limit line at Old Brick Rd., thence following the centerline of Old Brick Rd. to the corporate limit line at Fiddler Ridge Rd., thence following the corporate limit line to Rt. 13, thence East to the corporate limit line at Watson Rd., thence North following the corporate limit line to the North Section line of Section 2 T9S R2W, thence East along the Murphysboro/Somerset Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T9S R2W and the point of beginning.

District #5: Commencing at the centerline of Old Hwy 13 from the centerline of Hwy 127 thence South Easterly following said centerline to the centerline of Wood Rd., thence North to the centerline of Striegel Rd., thence East following said centerline to the centerline of Rt. 13, following said centerline to Little Crab Orchard Creek, thence South along said creek to the centerline of Chautauqua street, thence East to the centerline of McLafferty Rd., thence South to the centerline of Poultry Center Rd., thence following said centerline to the centerline of Douglas Dr., thence following Douglas Dr. to the centerline of Lincoln Dr., thence following said centerline to the ICGRR, thence North along the ICGRR to a line even with Neely Dr., thence East to and along the centerline of Neely Dr., including Neely hall to the centerline of Logan Dr., thence North Easterly following said centerline to the centerline of East Park streets, thence West along the centerline of East Park street to the ICGRR, thence North to the centerline of Main street, thence East following said centerline to the centerline of Graham Ave., thence South along the centerline of Graham Ave. to the centerline of East Freeman street, thence East to the centerline of Wall street, thence South along the centerline of Wall street to the centerline of Pleasant Hill Rd., thence West to the ICGRR, thence South along the ICGRR to the South Section line of Section 9 T10S R1W, thence West along the South Section lines of Sections 9, 8, and 7 to the SW corner of Section 7 T10S R1W, thence North along the Makanda/Pomona Township line to the NW corner of Section 6 T10S R1W, which is also the SE corner of Section 36 T9S R2W, thence West along the Murphysboro/Pomona Township line to the centerline of Rt. 127, thence along said centerline to the point of beginning.

District #6: Commencing at the centerline of Sunset Dr., at Little Crab Orchard Creek, East along said centerline to the centerline of Canterbury Dr., thence along said centerline to the centerline of Dixon Ave., thence North along said centerline to the centerline of Main street, thence East to the ICGRR, thence South to the centerline of East Park street, thence East along said centerline to the centerline of Logan Dr., thence South following the centerline of Logan Dr. to the centerline of Neely Dr., thence along said centerline around Neely Hall to the ICGRR, thence South to the centerline of Lincoln Dr., thence South following the centerline of Lincoln Dr. to the centerline of Douglas Dr., following said centerline to the centerline of Poultry Center Rd., thence West along said centerline to the centerline of McLafferty Rd., thence North along said centerline to the centerline of



Chautauqua Rd., thence West along said centerline to Little Crab Orchard Creek, thence North following Little Crab Orchard Creek to the point of beginning.

District #7: Commencing at the ICGRR at the North Section line of Section 5 T8S R1W, East along the DeSoto/Elk Township line to the NE corner of Section 1 T8S R1W, thence South along the Jackson – Williamson County line to the SE corner of Section 36 T9S R1W, thence West along the Carbondale/Makanda township line to the ICGRR at the South Section line of Section 33 T9S R1W, thence North along said ICGRR to the centerline of East Pleasant Hill Rd., thence East along said centerline to the centerline of Wall street, thence North along said centerline to the centerline of East College street, thence East along said centerline to the centerline of Lewis Ln., thence North along said centerline to the centerline of Main street, thence West along said centerline to Piles Creek, thence North following said creek to the South Border of Attucks Park, thence West along the border of Attucks Park to the centerline of Wall street, thence North following said centerline to the East-West ICGRR, thence South Westerly following the ICGRR to the intersection with the North-South ICGRR, thence North along said ICGRR to the point of beginning.

11. The attached map of Jackson County represents the District boundary lines and is incorporated by reference and adopted as part of this ordinance.

12. The invalidity of any provision, clause, or part of this ordinance shall not effect the validity of the other provisions, clauses, or parts and the provisions of the ordinance are declared to be severable.


13. This ordinance shall take effect July 1, 2001.

ORDINANCE NO. 01 - 3

AN ORDINANCE SETTING REIMBURSEMENT FOR THE COST OF MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL SERVICES PROVIDED TO PRISONERS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE JACKSON COUNTY SHERIFF AT THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC AID RATES FOR MEDICAL ASSISTANCE.

WHEREAS, 730 ILCS 125/17 provides, in part, that the Jackson County Sheriff shall furnish necessary medical aid for all prisoners under his charge; and

WHEREAS, 730 ILCS 125/17 also provides, in part, that any hospital and/or physician providing medical services to a prisoner in the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff shall be entitled to obtain reimbursement from the County for the cost of such services; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Sheriff may provide some of its medical and related services to its jail inmates through a written contract with a medical provider; and it is not the intent of this ordinance to disturb or affect these type of arrangements now or in the future; and

WHEREAS, 730 ILCS 125/17 further provides, in part, that the County Board may by ordinance limit the reimbursement for hospital and/or physician services furnished to inmates to the rates set by the Illinois Department of Public Aid for medical assistance; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the citizens of Jackson County, Illinois for the County Board to limit the reimbursement for the cost of hospital and/or physician service provided to inmates in the Jackson County Jail to those rates established by the Illinois Department of Public Aid for medical assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the County Board of Jackson County, Illinois that:

1. Pursuant to 730 ILCS 125/17, reimbursement by the County of Jackson, Illinois for the cost of hospital and/or physician services provided to inmates in the custody of the Jackson County Sheriff shall be set at the Illinois Department of Public Aid rate for medical assistance.

2. Nothing herein shall be construed to affect any written contract. Nothing herein shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any Court or any rights accrued or liability incurred or any cause or causes of action accrued or existing under any prior Resolution or Ordinance. Nor shall any written contract, or any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

4. The Chairman of the County Board shall be authorized to sign this Ordinance on behalf of the entire County Board of Jackson County, Illinois.

ORDINANCE NO. 01-4

AN ORDINANCE TO ADD TERRITORY
TO THE JACKSON COUNTY ENTERPRISE ZONE
(JACKSON COUNTY)

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board established an Enterprise Zone through Ordinance No. 90-2, pursuant to authority granted it by the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act (The "Act"; P.A. 82-1019), as amended, subject to the approval of the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs, and subject to provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, an Intergovernmental Agreement was entered into between the County of Jackson, Illinois (hereinafter "County") and the Cities of Carbondale and Murphysboro (hereinafter collectively "Cities"), through which the governments designated certain areas, and any areas subsequently certified from time to time, as an Enterprise Zone pursuant to and in accordance with the Act, subject to certification of the State as in the Act provided, and known as the Jackson County Enterprise Zone; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Carbondale-Murphysboro Enterprise Zone was approved by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs, effective March 1, 1990; and

WHEREAS, a request has been made to expand the current Enterprise Zone area through the addition of a certain parcel of property, pursuant to authority of the Act, and subject to approval by the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs, and subject to provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the designating units of government through their designated zone administrator, and pursuant to statute, conducted at least one public hearing within the Enterprise Zone area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF JACKSON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section III of Ordinance 90-2, the Ordinance Establishing an Enterprise Zone for Jackson County, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding Exhibits A-21 and B-21 (which exhibits are attached to this ordinance and made a part thereof) to the list of Exhibits within said Section III.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances and parts thereof in conflict herewith are expressly repealed and are of no other force and effect.

SECTION 3. The repeal of any ordinance by this Ordinance shall not affect any rights accrued or liability incurred under said repealed ordinance to the effective date hereof. The provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they are the same or substantially the same as those of any prior ordinance, shall be construed as a continuation of said prior ordinances.

SECTION 4. That it is the intention of the Jackson County Board that this Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered separable, and the invalidity of any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That the Jackson County Board finds that the subject matter of this Ordinance pertains to the government and affairs of the Jackson County and is passed pursuant to authorities granted it by State statute and the Illinois Constitution.



SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 01-4 of the Jackson County, Illinois, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and recording, and after the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs has approved the application for amendment to the Enterprise Zone in the Jackson County, Illinois.



Thence Southerly along said Easterly Right-of-Way line of U.S. Route 51 to its intersection with the Northerly Right-of-Way line of Pleasant Hill Road; thence Easterly along said Northerly Right-of-Way line of Pleasant Hill Road to its intersection with the Westerly Right-of-Way line of the Canadian National/Illinois Central Mainline Track Right-of-Way line; thence Northerly along said Westerly Right-of-Way line of the Canadian National/Illinois Central Mainline Track Right-of-Way to the point of beginning, containing 39.7 acres, more or less.

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
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Jackson County Enterprise Zone

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ORDINANCE NO. 01-5

AN ORDINANCE TO ADD TERRITORY
TO THE JACKSON COUNTY ENTERPRISE ZONE

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board established an Enterprise Zone through Ordinance No. 90-2, pursuant to authority granted it by the Illinois Enterprise Zone Act (The "Act"; P.A. 82-1019), as amended, subject to the approval of the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs, and subject to provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, an Intergovernmental Agreement was entered into between the County of Jackson, Illinois (hereinafter "County") and the Cities of Carbondale and Murphysboro (hereinafter collectively "Cities"), through which the governments designated certain areas, and any areas subsequently certified from time to time, as an Enterprise Zone pursuant to and in accordance with the Act, subject to certification of the State as in the Act provided, and known as the Jackson County Enterprise Zone; and

WHEREAS, the designating units of government through their designated zone administrator, and pursuant to statute, conducted at least one public hearing within the Enterprise Zone area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD OF JACKSON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That Section III of Ordinance 90-2, the Ordinance Establishing an Enterprise Zone for Jackson County, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding Exhibits A-20 and B-20 (which exhibits are attached to this ordinance and made a part thereof) to the list of Exhibits within said Section III.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances and parts thereof in conflict herewith are expressly repealed and are of no other force and effect.

SECTION 3. The repeal of any ordinance by this Ordinance shall not affect any rights accrued or liability incurred under said repealed ordinance to the effective date hereof. The provisions of this Ordinance insofar as they are the same or substantially the same as those of any prior ordinance, shall be construed as a continuation of said prior ordinances.

SECTION 4. That it is the intention of the Jackson County Board that this Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered separable, and the invalidity of any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. That the Jackson County Board finds that the subject matter of this Ordinance pertains to the government and affairs of the Jackson County and is passed pursuant to authorities granted it by State statute and the Illinois Constitution.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 01-5 of the Jackson County, Illinois, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and recording, and after the Illinois Department of Commerce and Community Affairs has approved the application for amendment to the Enterprise Zone in the Jackson County, Illinois.







JACKSON COUNTY ORDINANCE 01-78

WHEREAS, the aforementioned ordinance established procedures for the County to follow in making determinations on applications seeking local siting approval; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to amend said ordinance for point of clarification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Jackson County Board hereby adopts the following changes as indicated to the Siting Ordinance for Pollution Control Facilities:

- 1) "Section 2. Procedures

DAY ONE

2. Applicant for site location approval shall file twenty-five (25) copies of the application including five (5) full sized copies of exhibits and twenty (20) reduced copies of all exhibits with the Jackson County Clerk, along with the appropriate site review application fee. The applicant is encouraged to use paper containing post-consumer recycled products. The applicant is required to provide up to ten (10) additional copies of the application to the County upon request.


Each application for a pollution control facility site which includes transfer, treatment, storage and/or disposal of hazardous material shall include a \$400,000 application fee and each application for a pollution control facility site which includes transfer, treatment, storage and/or disposal of non-hazardous material shall include a \$250,000 application fee, said fees to cover the reasonable and necessary costs, including but not limited to: notice costs, court reporter costs, hearing officer costs, transcription costs, consulting and engineering review costs, legal fees, and other expenses incurred by the County of Jackson in conducting the review of the request for site approval, the subsequent public hearing, and the approval decision. Each application for a permit modification which requires local siting approval ~~or expansion of an existing site~~ shall include a \$50,000 application fee for the reasonable and necessary costs as set forth herein above.

Any portion of the application fee that remains unexpended at the conclusion of the hearing process shall be returned to the applicant. Should there be any additional costs incurred by the County in excess of the application fee the applicant shall bear any and all additional costs."



**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE JACKSON COUNTY PRIVATE
SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, there exists a Jackson County Private Sewage Disposal System Ordinance, as amended, regulating and permitting the construction, repair and installation of private sewage disposal systems in Jackson County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the present ordinance is intended to amend the existing private sewage disposal system ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the present amending ordinance is adopted by virtue of the authority of the Jackson County Board, Jackson County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Private Sewage Disposal System Ordinance has established fees which need to be revised from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the amendment made by this present amending ordinance is for the purpose of revising the fees to cover the increasing costs of the Jackson County private sewage disposal program and to further supplement tax and grant monies also used to support this program; and

WHEREAS, the amendment made by this present amending ordinance is for the purpose of revising certain sections to be consistent with current private sewage disposal program requirements and policies, and

WHEREAS, the present amending ordinance has been duly approved by the Jackson County Board of Health.

**THEREFORE, THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD ORDAINS AND ADOPTS
THE FOLLOWING:**

1. The present amending ordinance shall be incorporated into the existing Jackson County Private Sewage Disposal System Ordinance, as amended, as if originally part of the Private Sewage Disposal System Ordinance; further
2. Section 2.7.1 shall be amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

2.7.1 There shall be a standard ~~\$100.00~~ \$125.00 permit fee charged for the issuance of a permit authorizing the construction, alteration, or extension of any private sewage disposal system. The fee shall be collected by the Health Department at the time an application for permit is submitted, and shall be deposited into the Health Department fund. If a permit is denied, the fee shall be returned to the applicant. In addition, the following fee schedule shall apply for other specific services rendered.

1.	Design of plans	\$25.00
2.	Percolation test (reading only)	\$25.00
3.	Subdivision plan review	\$100.00

A fee waived permit may be issued to non-profit organizations.

3. Section 2.7.2 shall be amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

2.7.2 There shall be a ~~\$100.00~~ \$125.00 fee charged for the purpose of assessing a private sewage disposal system or water supply system, or both during one site visit to a private residence when requested by the property owner, a prospective buyer, real estate agency, mortgage or loan institution, bank, etc. Additional fees may be charged to offset the cost of any additional site visit.

4. Section 2.10 shall be amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

2.10 The use of a private sewage disposal system to serve more than one property ~~or structure~~ is prohibited except where a common property is provided, under joint ownership of the users, or where the system is under public jurisdiction or managed by a district established for the maintenance of such systems.

5. Section 3.3.1 shall be amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

3.3.1 In addition to the annual registration fee in Subsection 3.3 there shall be an annual inspection fee of \$25 for each vehicle used for the collection and transportation of septage, except that this inspection and fee may be waived if the vehicle has been properly inspected by another local health department in Illinois.

6. Section 3.4 shall be amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

3.4 All private Sewage Disposal System Contractors ~~holding~~ must have a valid Private Sewage Disposal System Pumping Contractor or a Private Sewage Disposal System Installation Contractor license issued by the State of Illinois to obtain a Jackson County Contractor's Registration Certificate ~~shall attend a Private Sewage Disposal System Contractor's Training Course approved by the Health Department at least once every 3 years.~~





**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE JACKSON COUNTY
FOOD SERVICE SANITATION ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS, there exists a Jackson County Food Service Sanitation Ordinance, as amended, regulating and licensing certain food establishments located in Jackson County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, commensurate with the authority of the Jackson County Board to adopt certain ordinances regulating and licensing such establishments, from time to time, amendments to the existing ordinance are necessary; and

WHEREAS, the present amending ordinance is intended to amend, and not repeal, the Jackson County Food Service Sanitation Ordinance, and all its amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Food Service Sanitation Ordinance has established license fees for food service establishments and retail food stores which need to be revised from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the amendments made by this present amending ordinance are for the purpose of revising fees to cover the increasing costs of the Jackson County food safety program and to further supplement tax and grant monies also used to support this program; and

WHEREAS, the amendments made by this present amending ordinance are for the purpose of revising the required number of inspections based on current state requirements, and establishing new categories and fees to more proportionately distribute the cost of the food safety program based on number of required inspections; and

WHEREAS, the amendments made by this present amending ordinance are to revise the section covering waiver of fees for qualifying charitable organizations to include the license for a temporary food service establishment; and

WHEREAS, the amendments made by this present amending ordinance are to revise certain sections to update safe temperature requirements as applied to potentially hazardous food and to revise the section on inspection records to be consistent with current requirements and policies; and

WHEREAS, the present amending ordinance has been duly approved by the Jackson County Board of Health.

**THEREFORE, THE JACKSON COUNTY BOARD ORDAINS AND ADOPTS
THE FOLLOWING:**

1. The present amending ordinance shall be incorporated into the existing Jackson County Food



Service Sanitation Ordinance, as amended, as if originally part of the Food Service Sanitation Ordinance; further

2. Section A. 25. is amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

25. **SAFE TEMPERATURES** as applied to potentially hazardous food, shall mean temperatures of ~~45°F~~ 41°F or below, and 140°F or above. As applied to frozen perishable foods, safe temperatures shall be 0°F or below, ~~except for a variation of 15°F during transit, unloading or defrosting during a mechanical defrosting cycle.~~ Temperatures shall be determined by measurement of the actual product temperature or the ambient air temperature in the storage device.

3. Section B. 2. is amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

2. **FOOD PROTECTION:** All food, while being stored, prepared, displayed, served, or sold at food-service establishments or retail food stores, or during transportation between such establishments shall be protected from contamination. All perishable food shall be stored at such temperatures as will protect against spoilage. All potentially hazardous food shall be maintained at safe temperatures (~~45°F~~ 41°F or below, or 140°F or above) except during necessary periods of preparation and service. Raw fruits and vegetables shall be washed before use. Stuffing, poultry, stuffed meats and poultry, and pork and pork products shall be thoroughly cooked before being served. Individual portions of food once served to the customer shall not be served again; provided, that wrapped food which has not been unwrapped and which is wholesome may be ~~reserved~~ served again.

Only such poisonous and toxic materials as are required to maintain sanitary conditions and for sanitizing purposes may be used or stored in food-service establishments. Poisonous and toxic materials shall be identified, and shall be used only in such manner and under such conditions as will not contaminate food or constitute a hazard to employees or customers.

4. Section G. g. is amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

g. **FOOD TEMPERATURE:** Potentially hazardous food shall be stored and displayed at safe temperatures (~~45°F~~ 41°F or below, or 140°F or above, whichever is applicable). Adequate, properly constructed ~~or~~ and located mechanical refrigeration shall be provided for cold foods and adequate, properly constructed and located heating equipment shall be provided for hot foods.

5. Section H. g. is amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

g. **FEES:** The following fees shall be required for food service establishments and retail food stores.

The annual license fee for a food service establishment shall be determined by "seating capacity" and risk category. Establishments are reviewed annually in accordance with Illinois Department

of Public Health guidelines to determine if they are a Category I, II, or III establishment as defined in Section 750.10 of the Food Service Sanitation Code (77 Illinois Administrative Code 750). These definitions may be revised time to time in the Food Service Sanitation Code, but generally indicate that a Category I establishment presents a high relative risk, Category II establishment presents a medium relative risk, and Category III establishment presents a low relative risk of causing foodborne illness. Category I and II establishments require additional inspections since they present a higher relative risk of causing foodborne illness based on the large number of food handling operations typically implicated in foodborne outbreaks and other factors. The "Special High Risk" category are establishments where 3 or more additional inspections, or more than 5 recheck inspections, were needed during the previous annual license period. The application fee for a plan review shall be determined by "seating capacity." The following fee schedule shall apply:

A waiver will only be granted if the organization can demonstrate an economic need for the waiver. All fees shall be made payable to the Jackson County Health Department and shall be deposited into the Jackson County Health Department funds.

6. Section H. 2. is amended as follows (additions are underlined - deletions are struck-out):

2. INSPECTION OF FOOD-SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS AND RETAIL STORES: ~~At least once every 6 months~~ In accordance with Illinois Department of Public Health guidelines, the Health Authority shall inspect each food-service establishment and retail food store located in the County of Jackson, State of Illinois, and shall make as many additional inspections and re-inspections as are necessary for the enforcement of this ordinance.



**AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE NAMES OF ALL STREETS, LANES,
ROADS OR HIGHWAYS IN THE UNINCORPORATED AREA OF
JACKSON COUNTY, ILLINOIS.**

WHEREAS, the Counties Code, 55 ILCS 5/5-1067 (West 2000) provides that county boards may name or may change the name of any street, lane, road or highway in the unincorporated area of the county; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Jackson County has previously approved and enacted Ordinance number 00-07, which Ordinance incorporated certain maps attached to the Ordinance. The maps named or renamed various streets, lanes, roads or highways situated in the unincorporated area of the county; and

WHEREAS, in conjunction with implementing and maintaining the emergency telephone system (911) in the county various streets, roads, lanes, and highways situated in the unincorporated area of the county have been named or renamed since the enactment of the previously mentioned County Ordinance number 00-07; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board deems it to be in the best interest of the residents of the unincorporated area that these named and renamed streets, roads, lanes, and highways be adopted as provided in this present Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board believes such naming and renaming of thoroughfares in the unincorporated area of the county is essential to sufficiently provide emergency services and emergency response to the residents of the unincorporated area of the county;


THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF JACKSON COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

A. Jackson County Ordinance 00-07 is hereby repealed effective upon the passage of this present Ordinance.

B. All streets, lanes, roads, highways and public ways in the unincorporated area of Jackson County, Illinois are hereby named or renamed, as shown and depicted on the attached Jackson County, Illinois map and road name list. Said map and road name list is incorporated herein and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set out.


C. This present Ordinance shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.

ORDINANCE 01-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING COUNTY SITING ORDINANCE FOR POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Board adopted a Siting Ordinance for Pollution Control Facilities (Ordinance # 00-3) on February 9, 2000 and amended said Ordinance on August 8, 2001 (Ordinance #01-7); and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned ordinance and amendment established procedures to follow for the siting of all pollution control facilities in Jackson County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the County wishes to amend said ordinance to clarify and simplify procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the Jackson County Board hereby adopts the following changes as indicated to the Siting Ordinance for Pollution Control Facilities:

- 1) The following underlined portions shall be added to the ordinance; and the ~~struck out~~ portions shall be deleted:

“Section 2. Procedures

WITHIN 14 DAYS OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATION

4. County Clerk shall notify in writing forward the application in a general mailing to all affected departments or units of government of the filing of the application. The following, at a minimum, shall be notified:

- a. County Highway Department
- b. All municipalities within 1.5 miles of the proposed facility
- c. Township Supervisor
- d. Fire Protection District
- e. ~~District State General Assembly Members~~”

- 2) The present amendments shall inserted and incorporated into the existing Siting Ordinance for Pollution Control Facilities as if originally set forth therein.
- 3) The changes made by this amending ordinance shall be effective upon approval and adoption of the Jackson County Board.
