Public Notice is hereby given that Early Voting, per 10 ILCS 5/19A will be conducted in the office of the Jackson County Clerk. All Precincts in Jackson County will be served at the County Clerk's Office, Jackson County Courthouse, 1001 Walnut St., Murphysboro, IL

Voting will be conducted during the following dates and hours for the March 17th, 2020, Primary Election.

At the County Clerk's Office on weekdays starting February 6th, 2020, from 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. each day, excluding scheduled holidays.

The Jackson County Clerk's Office will also be open on Saturday, March 14th, 2020, during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for the purpose of early voting.

Early voting for all Poll Centers will also be available at the Carbondale Civic Center on the days of March 3rd, March 5th, and March 10th, 2020, during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Also, SIU Student Center, March 2nd, March 11th, March 12th & March 13th, 2020, from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

WHAT IS EARLY VOTING? Early voting in Illinois is available for all elections. Any registered Jackson County voter may cast their vote prior to Election Day at the office of the County Clerk and any offered off-site location. No excuse or reason is required to early vote.
